FAST FACTS

- 130 girls between the ages of 7 and 18 from diverse backgrounds, participating in five individual choirs
- Rehearsals for individual PG choirs are scheduled on Mondays, Wednesday and Saturdays.
- Rehearsal home: Presbyterian Church of Chestnut Hill, 8855 Germantown Avenue (PG is a community-based professional girlchoir with no religious affiliation).
- Performances vary from PG's own full concerts to performing select repertoire with some of Philadelphia's most distinguished arts organizations.
- Recent collaborations include the Philadelphia Orchestra, Opera Company of Philadelphia, Curtis Institute of Music, Mendelssohn Club of Philadelphia, the Philadelphia Singers, the Network for New Music, Chamber Orchestra of Philadelphia, The Kimmel Center for the Performing Arts, Philadelphia International Festival of the Arts, and the Philadelphia Museum of Art.
- Founded in 2004
- PG repertoire is steeped in the classical tradition, including music from many cultures and time periods.
- PG choirs participate in local and regional choral festivals. The touring choir of PG undertakes a concert tour each year. Past tours include Iceland, the Pacific Northwest, Germany, the Czech Republic, Italy, Russia, Uruguay, and Argentina.
- PG auditions are low-key and fun.
- Tuition for PG for 2011-2012 season is between \$ 700 and \$ 800; a limited amount of scholarship money is available.
- PG's brother-choir is Keystone State Boychoir. Both choirs are members of Commonwealth Youthchoirs, co-founded by Joseph P. Fitzmartin and Steven M. Fisher.
