- 150 boys between the ages of 8 and 18 from diverse backgrounds
- KSB is not your average boychoir! Here's why:
 - KSB singers have fun making music, in rehearsal and in performance
 - KSB is committed to diversity in our membership and in our repertoire — we sing everything from Bach to Britten to Broadway
 - KSB boys have snacks and recreation time at rehearsals so they can get to know each other and form lasting friendships
 - Boys can still play sports or do other outside activities, as well as sing with KSB
 - Boys who sing with KSB have music-making opportunities they would have nowhere else
- Rehearsals for individual KSB choirs are scheduled on Wednesdays and Saturdays.
- Rehearsal home: First Presbyterian Church in Germantown, 35 West Cheltenham Avenue (KSB is a community-based professional boychoir with no religious affiliation).
- Performances vary from full concerts to singing the National Anthem at sporting events to performing select repertoire with some of Philadelphia's most distinguished arts organizations.
- Repertoire includes classical, sacred, and secular music—spirituals, world music and musical theater.
- KSB embarks on a spectacular concert tour each year. Past tours include South Africa, Brazil, the Pacific Northwest, Canada, Japan, Southeast Asia, Australia, Monaco, France, Germany, Austria, and Bulgaria.
- KSB auditions are low-key and fun.
- Tuition for KSB for 2009-2010 season is between \$675 and \$750; a limited amount of scholarship money is available.
- KSB's sister-choir is Pennsylvania Girlchoir. Both choirs are members of Commonwealth Youthchoirs, co-founded by Joseph P. Fitzmartin and Steven M. Fisher.
